
## Pennsylvania Brings in \$2.63 Billion in Revenue Collections

General Fund revenue collections for the month of September were \$2.63 billion, which was \$145 million less than expected.

Collections of \$473 million for corporation taxes came in below Department of Revenue projections by \$50 million. Sales tax collections of \$812 million were lower than expected, coming in \$21 million below the official estimate. The Personal Income Taxes collected were \$1.08 billion, which was below estimate by \$37 million.

For the 2016-17 Fiscal Year, General Fund collections of \$6.6 billion are below the official estimate by \$218.5 million.

## **General Fund Revenue vs. Estimates**


